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


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INSTITUTIONAL OVERVIEW AND MISSION












Fall 2023 Top Home States






Fall 2023 Top Counties







Undergraduate Degree Completion by Major


Top 10 Undergraduate Majors





Academic Year Graduate Student Credit Hours by Student Class Level





Each class section should be counted only once and should not be duplicated because of course catalog cross-listings.


